Disability Confident workshop

This workshop has been designed to support employers who are Disability Confident.

The workshop is facilitated by a psychological wellbeing practitioner and an employment advisor, using an evidence-based cognitive behavioural model alongside employment support.





Aim

The aim of this course is to raise awareness of mental health in the context of being a Disability Confident employer and to recognise and implement the support options available.

Objectives

- Understand what it means to be a Disability Confident employer and to demonstrate how to achieve the criteria for level 1, 2 and 3.
- Understand some of the most common mental health conditions encountered in the workplace, and how to support the mental health of self and colleagues in the workplace by utilising a cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT) approach.
- To have an understanding of: the Equality Act 2010, the workplace adjustments that can be made to support an employee, and how this relates to Disability Confident employers.
- To learn ideas and concepts about how to promote a healthy, nondiscriminatory working environment, using evidence-based CBT and employment support strategies.
- To recognise that a team approach can contribute to wellbeing and create a healthy culture in the workplace.
- To understand the relationship between workplace stress and sickness absence.
- To explore the impact in the workplace of positive boundaries, communication, disclosure and reasonable adjustments.
- Provide resources, information and signposting to individuals and organisations.
